NOTES:

- Student names will be placed into a randomizer, and the order that comes up is the order we will use to select times to present Presentations and Oral Defense (POD). Drawing will happen on 3/16/18.
- Students **MUST** show up during scheduled time. Presentations will be videoed (no do-overs).
- When selecting a time, the student must determine in advance any scheduling issues (missing part of a teacher's class). Once a scheduled time is selected, there won't be a change. I have to procure 2 other teachers to sit on your presentation defense team, and teachers are very busy people.
- Students may invite others to view their presentation, but once the presentation has begun, nobody will be allowed in or out of the room.
- Students must come in appropriate presentation attire, and there can't be ANY issues with the technology. Room 108 will be available for practice any time on 3/19 and 3/20, to check technology issues, room set up, etc.
- Students (whether submitting paper to COLLEGE BOARD or not) will submit to Mrs. Rager using *ENGRADEPRO.COM* (this could change for CB submitters, depending on info I receive back from Turnitin.com)
- Papers and PODs will be scored over the break, but Mrs. Rager is not allowed to disclose the score given on the AP Rubric. Mrs. Rager will score essays/presentations for course requirements after Spring Break using a different rubric. Once papers have been graded using the internal / non-College Board rubric, I will then ask all students wishing to submit their paper for scoring by the COLLEGE BOARD to upload using the digital portfolio **NO LATER THAN April 27, 2018.**
